

CASS COUNTY DRAINAGE BOARD MEETING
May 7, 2018

The Cass County Drainage Board met at 1:49 P.M. in room 203 of the Cass County Government Building. Those in attendance were members: Ralph Anderson, Jim Sailors, Jeff LeDonne, Surveyor Josh LeDonne, Secretary Brena Pearson and Attorney Jeff Stanton.

Ralph Anderson called the meeting to order.

MINUTES

Jeff LeDonne made a motion to approve the minutes from the April 2, 2018 meeting. Jim Sailors 2nd; motion carried unanimously.

EXPENSE CLAIMS

Jim Sailors made a motion to approve expense claims CCS-1140 thru CCS1155. Jeff LeDonne 2nd; Motion carried unanimously.

NEW WORK ORDERS

(126) Flynn Tile

Josh LeDonne reported the Flynn Tile needs 2- 24 inch risers put in, to try and get the water to the tile faster. Jim Sailors made a motion to approve the work. Jeff LeDonne 2nd; motion carried unanimously.

(120) Bell Tile

Josh LeDonne reported that the contractor took an old crossing out that was jammed up, and cleaned the ditch out. The contractor took the trees out and as he was burning the trees he burnt down the landowner's barn. The barn was of no value. Josh reports that the drainage board has nothing in this, it's between the contractor and the landowner.

(97) Frederick Open

Josh LeDonne reported this Open has 2 areas where the water coming into the ditch is washing the banks out. Josh is in the process of getting quotes to get this fixed, will probably put in overflow pipes. The farmer has been trying to fix this problem and has been having no results.

CURRENT PROJECT UPDATES

Josh LeDonne reported that all projects are complete. All ditches are dredged and leveled, spraying is not completed and won't be until the end of June.

OTHER BUSINESS

Tammy Robinson called, they had some repairs done on the Coleman Drain that runs through their farm, the sum of the claim is \$ 2500.00. Jim Sailors made a motion to pay the claim. Jeff LeDonne 2nd; motion carried unanimously.


PUBLIC COMMENTS


Kathleen Miller of Fulton County had some questions regarding who would be responsible to fix tile on her property if something were to happen during construction of the proposed wind farm.
