**NEW WORK ORDERS**

(39) Howard Tile

Josh LeDonne reported the Tile has suck holes that need to be fixed once the crops are in.

(113) Henry Knouff Open & Tile

The inlet on this open & tile is all broken down, as soon as the crops are in, need to get this repaired.

(68) Lutz Wendling Davis Open

We are going to start at the highway and dredge to 800 E., we are working with the county highway putting in a new culvert. The project is delayed right now due to the fact that we're waiting on Nipsco, called the locate out and the locate couldn't find the gas line, they said they would call Nipsco. Surveyor LeDonne has called Nipsco every day, they won't come out until the locate people call them, project is on hold until the gas lines are located.

All information was sent out for bids, September 4<sup>th</sup> meeting is when the bids will be in. Indian Creek

Work has started on putting in a couple of culverts on the Cass County side.


**PUBLIC COMMENTS**

He also has a concern with a sink hole on 150, he brought pictures in and presented them to the board. The sink hole in question , Mr. Gallaher estimates is 6 ft. deep and 8 ft long, he concerned about the bus that runs on that road. The board assured Mr. Gallaher that the County highway will be sent out there to look at this and determine

who's responsibility it is to fix, but in the mean time we will do something to temporarily fix this until it can be taken care of properly.
