Whereas, manufactures pay millions of dollars annually to support public education, law enforcement, emergency preparedness, public works and other essential services.


Now, therefore it be Proclaimed, that October 7, 2016 is hereby designated as

Whereas, in 1816 Indiana was admitted into the United States of America as the nineteenth state in the nation; and


