





SURVEYOR'S REPORT:

ON OCTOBER 2, 2009, A RAILROAD SPIKE WAS FOUND BURIED 5 INCHES BELOW THE SURFACE OF THE ROAD AND MATCHING PREVIOUSLY RECORDED REFERENCES. THE SAID PRIOR RECORDED REFERENCE INDICATED A FOUND PK NAIL IN THE ROAD INTERSECTION AND IN-LINE WITH FIELD DIVISION LINES TO THE EAST ON APRIL 24, 1991 AND REFERENCE MONUMENTATION SET. THE PRIOR REFERENCE ALSO INDICATED THAT A 4'X6'X3' HOLE WAS EXCAVATED ON SEPTEMBER 9, 1991, WHERE NO POST, PIT OR STONE WAS FOUND AND THAT THE PK NAIL WAS REPLACED WITH A RAILROAD SPIKE WITH CENTER PUNCH ON SEPTEMBER 23, 1991. ON DECEMBER 30, 2009, THE PRIOR REFERENCES WERE VERIFIED AND NEW REFERENCE MONUMENTATION WAS SET, AS SHOWN BELOW.

SURVEYOR'S REPORT:

ON OCTOBER 2, 2009, A RAILROAD SPIKE WAS FOUND BURIED 5 INCHES BELOW THE SURFACE OF THE ROAD AND MATCHED PREVIOUSLY RECORDED REFERENCES. THE PREVIOUSLY RECORDED REFERENCE INDICATED A FOUND RAILROAD SPIKE ON APRIL 24, 1991 AND CENTER PUNCH WAS SET AT THAT TIME. ON SEPTEMBER 9, 1991, THE COUNTY CONSIDERED EXCAVATION, BUT THE INTERSECTION APPEARED TO HAVE BEEN BACKFILLED 4'-5' AND DRAINAGE STRUCTURE POSSIBLY OBLITERATED ANY CORNER MONUMENT. SAID PRIOR REFERENCE HAS A WARNING TO FUTURE SURVEYORS REGARDING SPIKE'S LOCATION NOT FITTING FENCE/FIELD DIVISION TO THE WEST. ON OCTOBER 2, 2009, IT WAS DETERMINED NOT TO EXCAVATE, DUE TO SAID DRAINAGE STRUCTURE AND THE FOUND SPIKE WAS REFERENCED BY RANDALL MILLER AND ASSOCIATES. TWO OF THE THREE ORIGINAL REFERENCE POINTS WERE FOUND INTACT AND USED AS PART OF THIS REFERENCE.





SURVEYOR'S REPORT:

ON OCTOBER 2, 2009, A RAILROAD SPIKE WAS FOUND BURIED 5 INCHES BELOW THE SURFACE OF THE ROAD AND MATCHED PREVIOUSLY RECORDED REFERENCES. THE PRIOR REFERENCE INDICATED NO METAL SOUNDING AT R/W SPILT AND FIELD DIVISION NORTH AND SOUTH ON APRIL 24, 1991. ON SEPTEMBER 9, 1991, A 4'X5'X3' HOLE WAS EXCAVATED AT SAID R/W SPILT AND FIELD DIVISION NORTH, WHERE NO POST, PIT OR STONE WAS FOUND. THE PRIOR REFERENCE ALSO INDICATED FINDINGS OF A SMALL LOOP OF FENCE WIRE THAT HAD APPEARED TO HAVE BEEN WRAPPED AROUND A ROUND POST IN THE MIDDLE OF THE HOLE WHERE SPIKE WAS TO BE SET. ON SEPTEMBER 30, 1991, THE RAILROAD SPIKE WAS SET WITH CENTER PUNCH AT SAID 30' R/W SPILT AND FIELD DIVISION NORTH. ON OCTOBER 2, 2009, THE SPIKE WAS REMOVED AND A 4'X4'X3' HOLE WAS EXCAVATED BY RANDALL MILLER AND ASSOCIATES, INC., WHERE NO STONE WAS FOUND.TWO OF THE ORIGINAL REFERENCE MONUMENTS WERE FOUND INTACT AND USED AS SHOWN. ON NOVEMBER 23, 2009, THE RAILROAD SPIKE WAS RESET AT THE

SURFACE AT ITS FOUND LOCATION.

THE CASS COUNTY RECORDS PROVIDED NO PRIOR EXCAVATION HISTORY FOR THIS CORNER. ON DECEMBER 2, 2009, AN 18" TAPERED CONCRETE CORNER POST WAS FOUND WITH EXISTING FENCE LINES SITUATE EAST, WEST AND SOUTH FROM IT'S LOCATION. THE CASS COUNTY RECORDS PROVIDED NO PRIOR EXCAVATION HISTORY FOR THIS CORNER. ON DECEMBER 2, 2009, A 2 OR 3 MAN STONE WAS FOUND IN APPARENT DISTURBED CONDITION NEAR THE SURFACE OF THE GROUND AND NEXT TO THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE BASE OF AN 8" WOOD CORNER POST. THE STONE HAD APPARENT ORIGINAL MARKINGS "1/4 S" AND SAID MARKINGS WERE FOUND FACING THE GROUND. ON THE SAME DAY, THE STONE WAS REMOVED AND A 5/8" DIAMETER IRON REBAR WAS SET FLUSH WITH THE SURFACE OF THE GROUND NEXT TO THE SOUTH SIDE OF SAID WOOD CORNER POST. DUE TO EXISTING CROPS, IT WAS DETERMINED NOT TO SET NEW REFERENCE MONUMENTATION AT THIS TIME.
