Ralph Anderson called the meeting to order.

MINUTES

Jim Sailors made a motion to approve the minutes for March 4, 2019 meeting. Ryan Browning 2nd;

NEW WORK ORDERS

- A. (62) Conn Blackburn Open: Josh LeDonne reported to the board that there is a washout in the bank that needs repaired. Jim Sailors made a motion that we go ahead and get this ditch completed. Jeff LeDonne 2nd; motion carried unanimously.
- B. (116) Clary Tile: Suck holes need repaired.
- C. (52) Rolhausen Open: This Open empties into Crooked Creek, goes through the Franklin property, crosses 400 then comes across 35. The property owner would like some of the Open dipped. Surveyor LeDonne went out and looked, it does need to be addressed. There is \$5500.00 in the account, with \$ 500.00 of that going for the removal of beaver, that leaves \$5000. Surveyor LeDonne wants to do at least 4500 feet of the Open this spring to at least get the water flowing. Jim Sailors made a motion, Ryan Browning 2nd; motion carried unanimously.
