INDIANA ELECTION COMMISSION

WHEREAS, pursuant to IC 3-11-1.5-18(d), the Co-Directors of the Indiana Election Division (“the Election Division”) have received a filing of an objection to a proposed precinct establishment order for Cass County before the deadline for the filing of the objection (noon, January 4, 2022) and has notified the county executive of the filing of the objection;

WHEREAS, pursuant to IC 3-11-1.5-17, employees of the Election Division designated by the Co-Directors have examined the proposed precinct establishment order and determined that the proposed precinct establishment order complies with the standards set forth in IC 3-11-1.5.

WHEREAS, pursuant to IC 3-11-1.5-17, the Office of Census Data has reviewed the proposed precinct establishment order and provided technical comments to the Election Division and the Election Division has examined the technical comments of the Office of Census Data;

WHEREAS, the Co-Directors of the Election Division issued Order 2021-419 on December 14, 2021, authorizing Cass County to issue the proposed order pending any timely filed objection; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has conducted the requested hearing, and being duly advised by the Election Division and representatives of the County and the objector, have determined that the proposed Order should be approved;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED BY THE INDIANA ELECTION COMMISSION:

SECTION 1. The proposed precinct establishment order submitted by Cass County to establish certain precincts in Cass County is **APPROVED**. The proposed precinct establishment order and all other documents entered into the record of the Commission’s meeting of January 4, 2022, are incorporated by reference into this Order.


SECTION 2. This Order is effective immediately upon passage.




