

**ORDINANCE 15- 11**

**AN ORDINANCE CREATING FUND #490 - SHERIFF  
NON-REVERTING TRAINING FUND**

WHEREAS, I.C. 33-37-5-8, established the Alcohol and Drug Service Program fee and Law Enforcement continuing education program fee;

WHEREAS, the law provides for the following:

(c) In each action in which a defendant is found to have:

- (1) committed a crime;
- (2) violated a statute defining an infraction; or
- (3) violated an ordinance of a municipal corporation;

the clerk shall collect a law enforcement continuing education program fee of four dollars (\$4);  
and

WHEREAS, I.C. 33-37-4-1 provides for the collection of criminal costs and additional fees, more specifically, the collection of a law enforcement continuing education program fee (I.C. 33-37-5-8 (c)).

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CASS COUNTY COUNCIL AS  
FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The Council desires to create Fund #490, the Cass County Sheriff Non-Reverting Training Fund;




SECTION 2. The Council authorizes the Clerk to collect fees for the Cass County Sheriff's Non-Reverting Training Fund and deposit said fees with the Cass County Auditor;



SECTION 3. The Council authorizes the use of fees collected in the following manner:

1. Monies collected by the Cass County Clerk shall be deposited in a non-reverting account #4901 titled, Sheriff Non-Reverting Training Fund. Said funds may be utilized at the discretion of the Cass County Sheriff or Chief Administrative Officer, for training purposes for the Cass County Jail and Sheriff's department personnel; and
2. Any expenditures from said Fund will be processed through the filing of a claim with the Cass County Auditor identifying the intended use of said funds.
