

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CASS COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
AMENDING TITLE 7, CHAPTER 71, SCHEDULE 4, SECTION 3
OF THE CASS COUNTY CODE**

WHEREAS, the Cass County Commissioners feel a necessity to change the traffic control devices at the intersection of **CR 700E** and **CR 325S** to a 4-way stop in order to protect the general traveling public using public road intersections.

WHEREAS, pursuant to further continuing investigation, the Cass County Commissioners have decided that such traffic control devices need to be installed in and about such intersection;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

Section I. Chapter 7, Chapter 71, Schedule 4, Section 7 of the Cass County Code is hereby amended to create a four-way stop at the respectively designated intersection:


A. 4-way stop signs at this intersection:

Four-Way Stop at CR 700E and CR 325S;
